Important Notes

- 1 Co-Proprietors and Companies MUST complete a proxy to vote at the meeting**
- 2** A natural person can hold a proxy form. That person does not have to be a proprietor
- 3** If possible, please complete and return the proxy form to your Strata Manager with sufficient time (well before) the general meeting.
- 4** An incorporated proprietor should appoint a natural person as its proxy holder if it intends to vote.
- 5** If you want to revoke this proxy form, please give notice of revocation to the proxy holder and the Strata Manager.
